#### <Heian Jingu Shrine>

Heian Jingu was built in 1895 to celebrate the 1,100th anniversary of the transfer of Japan's capital to Kyoto. In 794 A.D., the Emperor Kanmu moved the capital from Nara to what is now Kyoto and named the new city "Heian-kyo", which means "the capital of eternal peace". The shrine's main buildings convey the atmosphere of elegance of the Heian Period (794-1185).
